Please make sure you label any and all items sent to Camp with your child



CAMP KENWOOD UNIFORM

- 4 grey traditional short sleeve t-shirts (required)
- 4 maroon traditional short sleeve t-shirts (required)
- 1 Kenwood sweatshirt (any style)
- 1 pair of maroon Kenwood shorts (any style) (required)
- 1 Kenwood reversible tank



CAMP EVERGREEN UNIFORM

- 4 yellow traditional short sleeve t-shirts (required)
- 2 green traditional short sleeve t-shirts (required)
- 1 Evergreen sweatshirt (any style)
- 1 Evergreen reversible tank

There are many other branded items available on our catalog which you may order at your discretion

NECESSARY ADDITIONAL APPAREL

- 14 t-shirts
- 1 t-shirt of each color for special events (black, green, yellow, red, blue, and white) These can be part of the 14 t-shirts that are required
- 2 all white t-shirts (for tie-dyeing)
- 4 long sleeve shirts
- 10 pairs of shorts
- 5 pairs of pants (jeans, athletic pants)
- 3 sweatshirts
- 14 pair of underwear
- 16 pair of inexpensive athletic socks
- 4 sets of comfortable sleep wear
- 4 swimsuits (at least 1 one-piece for girls)
- 4 UV protection shirts (if your child will wear them)
- 1 lightweight jacket/polar fleece
- 1 heavyweight jacket (if your child gets cold easily)
- 1 rain jacket or poncho

Footwear

- 2 pairs of sneakers (required for all campers)
- 1 pair of athletic field cleats (required for all campers)
- 1 pair of rainy day waterproof shoes (can use hiking boots)
- 2 pair of flip flops

Bed & Bath

- 2 blankets/1 comforter and 1 blanket
- 3 fitted twin sheet sets (top, bottom, pillow case)
- 1 pillow
- 8 towels (6 bath, 2 beach)
- 4 washcloths (if your child will use them)
- 1 bathrobe (if your child will use them)
- 3 laundry bags with name on them (yup, they really need 3!)
- 1 large mesh sock bag
- 1 foam egg crate (optional but most bring)

Toiletries

- 1 plastic shower caddy
- Soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, toothbrush holder, cup, hair brush, shampoo, conditioner, sunscreen, insect repellent, lip balm

CAMPING GEAR

- 1 sleeping bag with stuff sack (required for all campers)
- 1 camping pad (either foam or inflatable - this makes camping more comfortable)
- 1 flashlight & extra batteries
- 1 water bottle (required for all campers)
- 1 school-style daypack/backpack
- 1 framed backpack (for campers completing 7th grade in June 2018 or older campers intending to climb Mt. Washington)

STATIONARY & EXTRAS

- Set of stationary, stamps and address labels
- Extra pens or pencils

ITEMS TO CONSIDER

These are in no way required, but are often asked for by campers

- Books and non-electronic board games
- Pictures and posters to hang up around the bed area
- 1-2 Stuffed animals (please no more than 2)
- Hair dryer (no flat/curling irons)
- Inexpensive digital camera
- Musical instrument/Music
- Fishing rod & tackle
- 1 set of extra eyeglasses
- MP3 player (must not be able to play videos, games or apps)
- No iphones, ipads, itouches or nooks. Kindle paperwhite is ok
- Battery powered fan
- Crazy creek/camp anywhere chair
- Small floor mat for next to bed
- Book light/head lamp
- Nose clip, ear plugs or swim goggles (if your child will use them)

ATHLETICS

- 1 pair of soccer shin guards (required for all campers)
- 3 pair of soccer socks (required for all campers)
- 1 tennis racquet (required for all campers)
- 1 baseball/softball glove (required for all campers)
- 1 batting helmet (if your child plans to use the batting cage regularly)
- 1 baseball cap (required for all campers)
- 1 lacrosse helmet (if your child plans to participate)
- 1 lacrosse goggles (if your child plans to participate)
- 1 lacrosse gloves (if your child plans to participate)

PACKING & SHIPPING - 2 soft trunk/cargo bags with name clearly on them (please no hard trunks or footlockers)
